

BIBLIOGRAPHY

Works are listed by (first) author, if known; otherwise, by (first) editor in most cases. Short anonymous works contained in an edited collection are listed separately by title. See also the list of abbreviations at the front of this study. Alphabetisation generally follows Scandinavian rules.¹ Where appropriate (i.e. Icelanders, authors without surnames) authors are listed by first name. No distinction is made between long and short Icelandic vowels, or *d* and *ð*. With noted exceptions, the sorting order is generally: a, b, c, d (= *ð*), e, f, g, h, i, j, k, l, m, n, o, p, q, r, s, t, u, v, w, x, y, z, þ, æ (= *ä*, *œ*), ö (= *ø*, *ø*), å (= *aa*).
